In recent data, about 73% of individuals detained by ICE have no criminal convictions, while only 5% have a violent criminal conviction. The majority of those detained are arrested for civil immigration violations rather than serious crimes.

Justice Department refuses to defend campaign spending limitation.

The Supreme Court hasn't decided yet, but if it rules in favor of the GOP it will affect how tens of millions of dollars are spent in this year's midterms — and how many ads flood the airwaves and the Internet in the months before November.

Every immigrant, both legal and illegal, is subject to detention

Trump took office vowing to detain and deport what he claimed were illegal, criminal immigrants. But in July, ICE quietly adopted a policy that radically transformed the treatment of *all* immigrants living in the United States: Rather than the presumption that they would live freely — unless an immigration judge determined they were dangerous or likely to flee their proceedings — ICE would instead classify them as “applicants for admission,” a legal designation that requires them to be locked up without the opportunity for bond.

Evading Congress' “power of the purse”

Last summer White House budget director Russ Vought started talking publicly about using “pocket rescissions” to cancel federal cash without the approval of Congress, even though the federal government's top watchdog and lawmakers on both sides of the aisle decried the tactic as illegal. Typically, when a president sends Congress a rescission request, the House and Senate affirm or reject it. If the request is transmitted with less than 45 days to go before the end of the fiscal year, Vought and other top Trump advisers argue the president can cancel the funding in question.

Pull out of the Paris agreement (again) The President has signed off on withdrawing from the Paris climate agreement - the landmark international deal to limit rising global temperatures. He will have to wait a year before it happens. He previously withdrew in 2017, before Biden re-entered. World Health Organization dummy signed an executive order to begin the process of withdrawing the US from the UN's health body, the World Health Organization (WHO).

The Cost of Immigration Detention

The growth of immigration detention in the U.S. in recent decades has been highly costly to American taxpayers. Recent developments have only increased detention spending, which had remained nearly at or above three billion dollars from FY 2019 through FY 2024. The One Big Beautiful Bill Act (OBBBA), enacted in July 2025, includes \$45 billion for expanding detention capacity over the next four years. The reconciliation package ensures an additional \$11.25 billion for ICE detention per year. This exceeds the Department of Justice's budget request of \$8.25 billion for FY2026 for the entire federal prison system, which holds more than 155,000 inmates. As a result of the OBBBA, ICE's total detention budget for FY2025 surpassed \$14 billion, more than 400% greater than the funding for detention in FY2024 and nearly 800% greater than FY2010 immigration detention funding.

The expansion of ICE detention spending under the second Trump administration represents the largest investment in immigration detention in U.S. history. Detention funding has increased more than 400% from approximately \$3 billion in FY2019 to over \$14 billion in FY2025, with projections exceeding \$15 billion in FY2026. The OBBBA commits taxpayers to \$11.25 billion annually in additional detention spending through FY2029, locking in this unprecedented funding level for years regardless of changing enforcement needs, in the absence of action by a future Congress.

Abuse in the form of rape and torture has been documented at ice facilities, not to mention the horrific treatment of the deported.

Remember, in 2024 the legislature almost passed immigration reform, but trump used his influence to squelch that. He wanted this to happen.

We are doing human rights violations that we used to condemn. And it wasn't about immigration, it's about dividing the populace and taking control. Telling agents they can break into houses or arrest you for not having papers on your person.
